

CALL FOR APPLICATION FOR THE PARTICIPATION TO “ERASMUS+ BLENDED INTENSIVE PROGRAMME” (BIP) AT AALTO UNIVERSITY (FINLAND)

The call for applications is hereby published for the participation to “Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Program (BIP)” in *Doing and Understanding Design through Body and Brain*, from **2.10.2024** to **18.10.2024**. It will take place at the **Aalto University (Finland)**.

BIPs are short-term Intensive Study Programs, which include in-person and online attendance and in-person and online lessons. This program, specifically, will consist of a workshop on somatic experientiality, turned into a driving force of design and design analysis. Students will test a variety of somatic experiences such as entering spaces totally deprived of acoustics, swimming in cold water, etc., and will engage in exercises that will be used as a basis for design speculation. The focus will be also on other experiences, e.g., somatic media reactions, to map out the entanglement between body, space and digital media in a wide variety of ways.

The call, having deadline on **August 21st, 2024**, is addressed to students from the University of Naples Federico II who, at the moment of the application, are regularly enrolled in one of the following courses:

- ARC 5UE (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura a c.u.)
- MAPA/ACTA (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura Progettazione Architettonica / Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura per Comunità, Territori, Ambiente);
- DBE (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Design for the Built Environment);
- SdA (Corso di Laurea triennale in Scienze dell’Architettura);
- Dottorato di Ricerca in Scienze Filosofiche (Curriculum in Filosofia dell’Interno Architettonico).

In-presence activities will take place from **14.10.2024** to **18.10.2024** at Aalto University (Finland). The selected students must guarantee at least 5 days in presence. From **2.10.2024** to **3.10.2024** the activities will be carried out online.

All the activities will be held exclusively in English, thus knowledge of English language is required.

The students that will successfully complete the programme (virtual and physical mobility – both mandatory) will receive **3 ECTS**.

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

The Selection Committee will select **8** students. Applicants should be regularly enrolled in one of the aforementioned courses for the academic year 2024/25.

3. APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Interested students must apply by the deadline **August 21st, 2024**, sending all the documents by e-mail to: ernestoramon.rispoli@unina.it

The following documents must be provided:

- Academic career (completed exams and their scores);
- Certificate (or self-certification) of enrollment in one of the following courses:

- ARC 5UE (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura a c.u.)
 - MAPA/ACTA (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura Progettazione Architettonica / Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Architettura per Comunità, Territori, Ambiente);
 - DBE (Corso di Laurea Magistrale in Design for the Built Environment);
 - SdA (Corso di Laurea triennale in Scienze dell'Architettura);
 - Dottorato di Ricerca in Scienze Filosofiche (Curriculum in Filosofia dell'Interno Architettonico).
- Motivational letter in English (max 250 words);
- Project portfolio (PDF format, maximum size 3 MB).

4. CRITERIA FOR THE SELECTION:

The Commission will assign the score as follows:

- Max. 60 points for the evaluation of the academic career;
- Max. 40 points for the motivational letter and project portfolio.

In case of incomplete documentation the application will be rejected.

5. PUBLICATION OF RANKINGS

Rankings will be published on the Department's websites starting from **August 26th, 2024**.

6. FINANCIAL CONTRIBUTION

The selected students will be financially supported according to the norms of the Erasmus+ Programme.

The financial contribution amounts to **79 euro per day of mobility**.

Extra funding will be also available for students with fewer economical opportunities (ISEE < €15,000). However, more detailed information about the financial contribution will be provided to selected students by the Erasmus office.

7. DATA PROCESSING

Information on the processing of personal data pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 679/2016 laying down rules on the processing of personal data and the code regarding the protection of personal data, Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 supplemented and amended by Legislative Decree No. 101/2018.

By filling in, delivering, and transmitting the forms required for participation in this selection notice, the student provides his personal data to the University of Naples Federico II and assumes the quality of "interested party" to the processing of such data pursuant to of the art. 4, 1) of the EU Regulation.

PURPOSES AND MEANS OF PROCESSING: The personal data provided during the application for participation or acquired subsequently during the relationship with the University will be processed for institutional purposes, in

particular for administrative and accounting obligations related to the agreement. To this end, personal data such as name, surname, residence, personal data, tax code, contact details, address, email, data relating to the qualifications held, to the school career may be collected.

Personal data will be processed by authorised personnel both electronically, through the computerized management of the data, and in paper mode, through the collection, storage and use of documents in files, dossiers, and archives.

MANDATORY PROVISION OF DATA AND CONSEQUENCES OF ANY REFUSAL: the processing of personal data is mandatory for the purpose of assessing the requirements for participation in the aforementioned call. Particular categories of data (judicial data and particular state of health) are provided voluntarily to allow the University to carry out the procedure and/or the provision of the related services for participation. For these reasons, consent to the processing of data is not required. Any refusal will make it impossible for the University to fulfil these purposes and participation in the program.

COMMUNICATION AND DISSEMINATION OF DATA: Personal data will be processed for the performance of institutional activities according to the principles of lawfulness, necessity, non-excess, relevance and correctness, in accordance with European and national legislation and the University Regulations on the subject; the data may be disclosed in particular to the following subjects (Erasmus+ National Agency - INDIRE; European Commission, Ministry of Education, University and Research; University; Host company; Affiliated banking institution).

In compliance with the provisions on Transparent Administration (Legislative Decree No. 33/2013 and subsequent amendments) personal data, with the exception of the particular categories – referred to in articles 9 and 10 of the EU Regulation – are disseminated through publication on the university's institutional website for the period provided for by law.

RIGHTS OF THE INTERESTED PARTY: At any time the student may exercise his rights pursuant to articles 15-22 and 77 of the EU Regulation, where the conditions are met.
